


-REMOVAL-

- 1. Removing the number plate, side cover, and mud guard.
 - a) Remove the left and right number plate.
 - b) Remove the left and right side airbox covers.
 - c) Remove mud guard.
- 2. Removing the stock exhaust system.
 - a) Loosen left muffler exhaust clamp.
 - b) While securely supporting the left muffler, remove muffler mount bolt and carefully remove left side muffler.
 - c) Loosen the exhaust clamp on tailpipe to header connection.
 - d) Remove chassis mount bolt securing tailpipe assembly to subframe.
 - e) While securely supporting the right muffler, remove muffler mount bolt and carefully remove right muffler and tailpipe assembly.
 - f) Remove the (2) header nuts and carefully remove stock header.

-INSTALLATION-


1. Small parts installation.

- a) Install (Z1023) rubber grommet into left and right muffler brackets.
- b) Install (ALS-043) aluminum spacer into (Z1023) rubber grommet as shown in the diagram.



- 2. Installing the Yoshimura Full-System Exhaust.
 - a) Install Yoshimura header using the stock header nuts. Do not torque at this time. NOTE¹: Stock exhaust port gaskets will be re-used with the Yoshimura exhaust system. Inspect and replace exhaust port gasket if necessary.
 - NOTE²: Hook (RACE-SPX-1) exhaust springs onto flange. It may be difficult to install spring onto flange after header is installed.
 - b) Slide tailpipe onto header and bolt the tailpipe to chassis mount using the stock bolt. Start threads by hand to prevent cross-threading. Do not torque at this time. NOTE: The stock chassis mount shim will not be used.
 - c) Install left and right muffler onto tailpipe outlets and secure using the provided (M8X35H) muffler mount bolts and (8MMWASHERL) washer. See diagram for proper orientation.
 - d) Torque muffler mount bolts and tailpipe chassis mount bolt to 19lb-ft. (26Nm, 2.6kg-m)
 - e) Torque header nuts to 15lb-ft. (21Nm, 2.0kg-m)

 f) Install the (RACE-SPX-1) short exhaust springs onto muffler to tailpipe connection. See diagram for proper orientation and order of hardware. NOTE: Install spring on muffler spring hook tab from the inside out to prevent spring from rubbing on muffler front cap.



- g) Install (RACE-SPX-1) short exhaust springs onto header flange to header.
- h) Install (RACE-SPS-1) medium exhaust spring onto header to tailpipe connection.
- 3. Reinstall number plate, side cover, and mud guard.
 - a) Re-install left and right side number plate.
 - b) Re-install left and right side airbox covers.
 - c) Re-install mud guard.
- 4. Fitment check and Notes.
 - a) Before starting motorcycle, check for proper clearance between new exhaust system and rear suspension (i.e. tire, swing-arm, brake, rear shock, engine, and etc.) If any problem is found, please carefully follow through the installation steps again. If problem still persists, please call Yoshimura Tech Department at (800) 634-9166 / in CA (909) 628-4722.
 - b) It is recommended that the muffler and tailpipe be wiped down with rubbing alcohol to remove oil and fingerprints. This will help prevent tarnishing of the finish after the exhaust is heated up.
 - c) NOTE: After starting motorcycle, it is normal for new exhaust system and muffler to emit smoke until oil residue burns off.
